Flattop House Bricks

The Children's Museum of Oak Ridge announced the VICTORY BRICK campaign to raise funds to complete the Flat Top House Exhibit. Bricks are \$250 each. Funds will help complete the project, maintain the house, and create a historic and educational exhibit that captures Oak Ridge's rich history. The new brick sidewalk will include the original AMSE bronze donation plaques as part of the hardscape display.



Weinberg Papers Project

Great progress was made on this CMOR project in 2019. The project archivist prepared the first 90 boxes of the collection for permanent archival storage. This included removing the papers from filing cabinets and transferring them to archive quality storage folders and boxes, developing a finding aid, and creating metadata (descriptions) for the boxes. ACS **Document Imaging of Knoxville was** selected to digitize the collection, processing 69 boxes. In order to feature the project, the Thorium Energy Alliance held its 10th Annual Conference in Oak Ridge. The conference included presentations about Dr. Weinberg and a booth for project fundraising. Also in 2019, individuals from the community were interviewed about their memories of Alvin Weinberg. Their videos were posted on the project's web page.
